

Under the examination regulations, any candidate may contact the certifier's disability-access officer to adapt the assessment conditions and obtain assistance from a third party during the evaluation. The materials and equipment required for the assessments can be modified accordingly. On the advice of the disability-access officer, and in keeping with the requirements of the certification framework, the assessment format itself may be adjusted. Upon a duly reasoned recommendation from the disability-access officer, the certification jury may decide to waive certain assessment criteria provided that both of the following conditions are met:

- 1. The exemption does not call the candidate's overall professional competence into question.
- 2. Because of the nature of the disability, the criterion would not apply in the candidate's future professional practice.

This programme also grants you access to the Financial Portfolio Management programme.

EXAM

Students are hereby informed that successful completion of the programme is strictly contingent upon passing the final examination.

This examination takes the form of a compulsory case study whose purpose is to assess each student's ability to apply—appropriately and effectively—the skills acquired during the course.

To have their training validated, students must complete the case study under the prescribed conditions and obtain at least the minimum mark required in line with the established assessment criteria.

If this examination is not passed, no certificate of completion can be issued
